THREE-YEAR DEAL WITH AUDI

Ochoa Sets Sights On Becoming Number One

"My goal will be to continue working hard to be number one," stated Ochoa.

"From this moment and going forward, my focus will be on winning every tournament I play in. My goal is to be consistent so that points can be accumulated, and we can

achieve our short-term and long-term objectives."

Audi will be Ochoa's official car, and she will wear the four- ring Audi logo on her left sleeve. Audi has been a supporter of Lorena Ochoa virtually since the inception of her career. The alliance will benefit both Ochoa and Audi, since they share the same values: commitment, innovation, and enthusiasm.

After a dominant collegiate career in which Ochoa won 12 of 20 tournaments, she turned pro in 2003. 2006 proved to be a break-out year, as Ochoa won six tournaments, becoming the second female golfer ever to break the two-million dollar mark in earnings.
